
All courses taking place in the second semester are available on the Department platforms.

Access to the platform


For access to the platform Log in (above on the right) using your university credentials (the same used for Payslip)

Announcements


The ANNOUNCEMENTS link allows to send messages to all students enrolled in the course. In addition to being sent to all students, announcements remain available in this section of the platform.



Educational forum

The EDUCATIONAL FORUM link provides access to a public discussion space where both teachers and students can participate.

One or more files in different formats can be attached to the message.



Teaching materials

The TEACHING MATERIALS link provides access to a folder that can be used, for example, to make teaching materials available to students. Different types of files can be used: slides, texts, audio and video files in various formats.
